LEST WE FORGET

ANZAC Day is a solemn day for many of us. Australians have faithfully commemorated this day in honour of those men and women who have served in our armed forces to selflessly protect our country and the countries of our allies. 'LEST WE FORGET' is a motto known by all Australians, both young and old.

In particular, we honour those who have paid the ultimate sacrifice with their life to ensure a better future for their families and future generations. As Christians, we should use ANZAC Day to meditate on the supreme sacrifice that Jesus Christ made on the cross. He didn't just give His life for his family or country but gave His life for every human being that has ever lived. Yet the majority of people fail to recognise His sacrifice even though it was for them that He died. Romans 5:6 says, "For while we were still helpless, at the right time, Christ died for the ungodly."

His death means we can have a future that will continue forever in His presence. We were dead in our sins but have now been made alive when we place our faith and trust in Him. We have this promise in Romans 6:4-11, "Therefore we were buried with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we too may walk in newness of life. For if we have been united with him in the likeness of his death, we will certainly also be in the likeness of his resurrection. For we know that our old self, was crucified with him so that the body ruled by sin might be rendered powerless so that we may no longer be enslaved to sin, since a person who has died is freed from sin. Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him, because we know that Christ, having been raised from the dead, will not die again. Death no longer rules over him. For the death he died, he died to sin once for all time; but the life he lives, he lives to God. So, you too consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus."

Let us never forget the one who made the greatest sacrifice of all. LEST WE FORGET.

Residency By Dillons — Flu Vax Requirements

After 3rd May a person will not be able to visit an Aged Care Facility unless they have had a Flu Vaccination. Visitors will be required to show written evidence of having received a flu vax prior to being able to enter the facility for any purpose. Flu vaxs are available at some pharmacies as well as at the GP surgeries.

This will have an impact for anyone wanting to attend our monthly church services held at Dillons. Our next service will be on 5th May.
