# **Using Time Wisely**

(by Jerry Rankin - In The Secret Place Devotional)

"So teach us to number our days, that we may present to Thee a heart of wisdom." (Psalm 90:12)

My self-image has never been consistent with my age. My concept of "middle age" used to be an adult thirty-five to fifty years old, and anyone beyond fifty years of age was old. However, I now consider middle age forty-five to sixty, and one cannot be considered old prior to age seventy! The length of time between birthdays for a child is long, but time seems to accelerate with the pace of activities and studies once you are in school. That, however, is only a precursor to the frequency at which the pages of the calendar whiz by as an adult. The responsibilities of family and career intermingled with all the pressures and demands of life eliminate any semblance of margin. We find ourselves looking back, wondering where the year has gone and, indeed, wondering how our life has passed so quickly.

Time is an element of creation and belongs only in this world. For a timeless and eternal God, there is little difference between a thousand years and a day. But He who is everlasting created the world as our dwelling place, and we have a stewardship to the One who gave us life to use the time we are given appropriately. We no longer have the nine hundred plus years of a Methuselah; typical longevity is only seventy to eighty years. Though life may be extended for some, we need to recognize that the years of productivity and influence are limited. One with a heart of wisdom will understand this and realize how important it is to use each day in serving the Lord and living for Him.

We need to have the wisdom to use each day to the maximum, living in obedience to God's will, serving others and seizing every opportunity to make an impact on our world.

In The Screwtape Letters, C. S. Lewis alerts us to the fact that one of Satan's most effective tactics is to get us to procrastinate. He lets us have plans for what we are going to do sometime in the future and good intentions for serving the Lord as long as we never get around to them. We are reminded that it is only in the present that time touches eternity, for the future is not yet reality and the past is simply a lost opportunity. God sweeps away each day like a flood in the night, but the marvelous thing is that He gives us a new one each morning! "It flourishes and sprouts anew" (v. 6) with fresh opportunities. We need to have the wisdom and foresight to use each day to the maximum, living in obedience to God's will, serving others and seizing every opportunity to make an impact on our world.

How sad if our days are the object of God's wrath and are consumed by His anger in His having to deal with our iniquities and secret sins. We need to pray that His favor would be upon us and that He would confirm our work. Paul reminds us in Ephesians 5:15–16 that we are to "be careful how [we] walk, not as unwise men, but as wise, making the most of [our] time, because the days are evil." Our desire should be that all our days would be filled with gladness and joy because we experience God's loving-kindness.

### "Come near to the radio and let's pray together"

REACH BEYOND We recently heard of the passing of our friend, radio listener and pastor, Rajesh. He did not die of Covid. He got sick and could not be

treated due to Covid-created conditions. He was born into an orthodox Hindu family, grew up in poverty, and became addicted to drugs and alcohol. His parents had him marry a kind girl, although life was no less than hell on earth for her.

One day, someone told her of a radio program. She became a listener, and heard the pastor say, "If you believe God can change your life, just believe and I will pray with you. In faith reach out, come near to the radio and let's pray together". And she did. Rajesh was healed from his addiction and began to share Jesus with the marginalised in Delhi.

I am moved by this incredible story, of a life transformed that began with a friend introducing Rajesh's wife to listen to a pastor share the Good News through one of our programs.

Please continue to pray for Rajesh's wife, and for our many friends and partners in India who are struggling with sickness and with the deaths of so many friends and family.
