(by Charles Spurgeon - The Cheque Book of the Bank of Faith)

"For the Lord will not forsake his people for his great name's sake; because it hath pleased the Lord to make you his people."

1 Samuel 12:22

GOD'S choice of his people is the reason for his abiding by them, and not forsaking them. He chose them for his love, and he loves them for his choice. His own good pleasure is the source of their election, and his election is the reason for the continuance of his pleasure in them. It would dishonour his great name for him to forsake them, since it would either show that he made an error in his choice, or that he was fickle in his love. He has not wrought such wonders for us that he might leave us after all. His Son Jesus has died for us, and we may be sure that he has not died in vain. Can he forsake those for whom he shed his blood? Because he has hitherto taken pleasure in choosing and in saving us, it will be his pleasure still to bless us. Our Lord Jesus is no changeable Lover. Having loved his own, he loves them to the end.

Jurassic Ark

Located just 20 minutes outside of Gympie (near Bells Bridge) is Jurassic Ark - The Aussie Creation Museum.



This is a unique site displaying the spectacular evidence showing God's word is true from beginning to end. Walk through history from Adam to Australia.

See the evidence of brilliant creation, the consequences of the curse, the fossil evidence of Noah's flood, and the whole family history of man.

Come and explore our exposed flood fossil log jam site, where fossil Aussie trees are embedded in the Jurassic sandstone rock. Learn how to dig up fossils, find petrified logs, and even watch stalactites grow.

The museum has been under development since 2011. It contains 200 metres of Murals to identify the various stages of Biblical history, i.e. Creation, the Fall of Man, Noah's Flood, the Tower of Babel, and the dispersion of people. You can see the basic truths of God's genius of design, His skill at creating, and His power of destruction, along with the sad consequences of man's rebellion or sin.

Jurassic Ark illustrates one thing clearly — the facts never contradict the Bible, only the opinions of men do that.

Lighthouse Kids is for children 3 years old to the end of grade 6. It runs each week of the school term during the sermon in our Sunday worship service. Our program includes bible lessons and follow-up activities.

Breakfast Club (a ministry of School Chaplaincy) is run on Tuesday and Thursday mornings at the Tin Can Bay State School. This is a fantastic way to minister to those students who are less

fortunate and also a great time to get to know the kids. "If we can give just a handful of children a good start to the day, then it is worth it."
