☐ I can still remember my flight instructor telling me to "believe your instruments." Always. Oh, for sure when the weather is beautiful, you can look out the window. But when you can't look out, well, that's right, "trust your instruments." That is the reason you have them; it takes the guesswork out of things.

As we live the Christian life, we need to trust our instrument - the Word of God - at all times.

66 Books, 1189 Chapters, 31173, Verses, and 807,361 Words – containing everything God knew we would need in terms that He knew we could understand. Note with me the verse below. It makes it clear that God has given us everything.

2 Peter 2:2-3,"Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord; seeing that His divine power has granted to us **everything pertaining to life and godliness**, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence."

Do we need to study? Of course. Are there some things that are hard to understand? Of course. **Ephesians 3:3 & 4**, however, contain good news. By inspiration Paul writes, "...by revelation there was made known to me the mystery, as I wrote before in brief. By referring to this, when you read, you can understand my insight into the mystery of Christ."

The point is this. Just like flying, you must trust your instruments, or you will find yourself in danger and put others in danger. The same is true of God's Word. We must believe His words, as recorded in the Bible. If not, we will find ourselves in great danger. That is a danger not only in this life but the next.

Over the centuries the Bible has been attacked by many individuals and groups, but when the truth was fully known, the Bible has always been proven to be correct, right and true.

As in believing your instruments, believe THE BOOK.

To add to its anti-conversion laws, the government has refused to grant land for burial places. The church in Nepal has grown remarkably in recent decades, and continues to grow in spite of the obstacles and opposition.

Churches and Bible training Institutions need wisdom and courage in these difficult times.
