In the late 1970's, Kim Lineham, an 18-year-old young lady, was putting an enormous amount of work into her swimming career. On August 19, 1979, Kim broke the world record for the women's 1500-metre freestyle. How did she achieve this success? Her coach, Paul Bergen, stated that Lineham did endless exercises and swam 11 to 19 km per day. In an \* attempt to gain a better understanding of the rigors of such training, Kim ★ Lineham was asked what was the hardest part of her regimen. Her ★ response, "Getting in the water"

It is amazing that even for people who achieve great success, the hardest part is often just getting started. We want to lose weight. It is hard to ★ just start that diet and exercise. We want to eat right. It is tough to make ★ a healthy meal instead of eating out.

It is not so different on a spiritual level. We want to pray more. But then we allow the busyness of the day take hold and do not set a specific time. We want to read and study the Bible more. Unfortunately, we tell ★ ourselves a thousand different excuses to keep us from getting started then we do not even take that first step forward and speak to them.

Sometimes I wonder if the reason these things are hard is because they \* are easy. Let me explain. If God had asked for us to travel a great ★ distance to obtain an item and bring it back home and dedicate it to Him, we would do it. And yet, all God has asked of us is to love Him, obey ★ Him, and continue to pursue a relationship with Him (Luke 10:27).

It should be easy, yet in some respects, this is much more difficult to do. Let us not let the simplicity of God's commands deter us from obedience.

Let's do whatever it takes to build and keep our relationship with God.

Two years ago, when a prominent Christian

leader in Finland took to social media to challenge movements that promoted homosexual and trans-gender activities, the police launched an investigation against her. With the investigation now completed, Finland's Prosecutor-General has charged the woman and other leaders who supported her with incitement against a minority group, a crime punishable by a hefty fine or up to two years imprisonment. At stake is whether Christian beliefs can still be expressed in Finland.

This is becoming an issue across most Western countries, from where it will inevitably spread globally.
