## \*\*\*\* Mud

Why did Jesus send the blind man to the pool of Siloam to wash his eyes? Jesus could have just said, 'Be healed,' and the man's sight would have come to him on the spot. But he wanted the man to do something, to exercise obedience, so he sent him to the Siloam pool to wash his eyes. But there's an interesting little detail to the story. Before sending him off, Jesus smeared mud on his eyelids. The intriguing question is: Why? Have you ever seen anyone spit into the dirt, twirl it around with his finger, then take the mud and smear it over someone's eyes? How would you like it if someone did that to you?

It's obvious. The mud made the man want to obey. It was a nudging, an additional motivation for the man to go to the pool of Siloam to wash his eyes. The mud provided the motivation for the obedience that Jesus required.

We don't always understand why the mud gets in our eyes, but sometimes if it weren't there, we would never bring critical areas of our lives into obedience to Jesus Christ. And without obedience, the work of God can never be displayed in us. God, in His infinite grace and wisdom, sometimes uses mud to restore our sight.

'After saying this, he spit on the ground, made some mud with the saliva, and put it on the man's eyes. 'Go,' he told him, 'wash in the Pool of Siloam' (this word means sent) So the man went and washed, and came home seeing' John 9:6-7
