# State 'religion' of North Korea

North Korea is probably the world's most totalitarian state and has the strictest communist rule. It is a place of terrible persecution under the despotic rule of President Kim Jong-un. Tens of thousands of Christians have been starved, tortured and worked to death in political labour camps (called 're-education' camps) because of their faith. The harshest and most inhumane punishments in such camps are often reserved for Christians. The above picture shows citizens of North Korea bowing before giant statues of founding leader Kim II-sung and his son Kim Jong-il (whose son Kim Jong-un is the current leader). Kim II-sung established the state-propagated ideology of *Juche*, or human 'self-reliance', which is in effect a religion requiring worship of Kim II-sung and his successors.
