God's Eye Is on Things We Deem Insignificant

Sometimes it seems that God is the only one who cares for sparrows. Cats and birds of prey like to hunt and eat them, and adults mostly consider them pests. Yet, Jesus said, "not one of them falls to the ground apart from your Father's will" (Matt. 10:29). It is interesting that Jesus chose the most common of all birds to teach a profound truth: in God's eyes, no one is insignificant!

God not only provides food for "the birds of the air," but He also "clothes the grass of the field" (Matt. 6:25-34). The "lilies of the field" were the scarlet poppies—they bloomed for only one day on the hillsides of Israel, and yet in their brief life they were clothed with a beauty which surpassed "Solomon in all his glory".

If God gives such beauty to a short-lived flower, how much more will He care for us?

Surely, God's generosity which is lavished upon a flower for one day will not be forgetful of humanity, the crown of His creation.

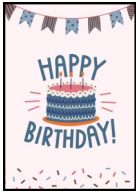
David was impressed by God's care for us:

Christians helping Ukraine

Christians in Ukraine continue bravely to serve their refugee neighbours by giving out millions of meals and often taking refugees into their homes to live. This sheltering of refugees is practised also beyond Christian families. It is an activity encouraged by a government that tries to avoid building large refugee camps. In parts of Ukraine affected by the war, education is in crisis. The war has displaced 665,000 Ukrainian students and 25,000 teachers. Christian organisations are showing care and stretching their resources by taking refugees into their schools.
