The word worship comes from the Old English *worthship* or *weorthscipe*. At the core of that word is the notion of worth, or worthiness, suggesting that our worship should only be directed to the person who is truly worthy.

Many people may be worthy of our thanks, our appreciation, our gratitude, our respect, but only One is worthy of worship.

The Bible is clear who that person is: *"I will call upon the Lord who is worthy to be praised."* Psalm 18:3

One of the songs we sing at church is called **"Worthy of it all"**. The chorus goes like this:

*You are worthy of it all
You are worthy of it all
For from You are all things
And to You are all things
You deserve the glory*

It expresses the fact that only God is worthy of all our praise.

King Nebuchadnezzar realised the same thing. Only the God of the Hebrews was worthy to be praised. He came to that conclusion after a prophecy about him was fulfilled in his own experience (Daniel 4:28-37).

He had witnessed the power of God through Daniel before, but this time it touched him personally.

God's worthiness grows with the realisation of His impact in our life. Praise Him today for not only what He has done for you in the past but what He can and will do for you and I in the future, remembering that He is worthy of it all (our praise) and that He deserves the glory (for what He has done for us through the cross).

Children's & Youth Ministries



Lighthouse Kids is for children 3 years old to the end of grade 6. It runs each week of the school term during the sermon in our Sunday worship service. Our program includes bible lessons and follow-up activities.

Youth Home Group is held on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of each month at Pastor Mick & Anne's place. It commences at 4pm and concludes after dinner.



Kids Club is for primary school children and is held every Tuesday afternoon from 3.30pm - 5.00pm during school term. The program includes afternoon tea, games, fitness, craft, songs and life lessons from the Bible.

Breakfast Club (a ministry of School Chaplaincy) is run on Tuesday and Thursday mornings at the Tin Can Bay State School. This is a fantastic way to minister to those students who are less fortunate and also a great time to get to know the kids.
